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Exhibitor Information Packet

Southern Arizona Gamers Association (SAGA) will be hosting a three-day convention celebrating tabletop gaming entitled RinCon. RinCon returned in 2012 under new management after a 1-year hiatus and has been a resounding success ever since! We cannot continue to be successful without your support as an Exhibitor. Please read this information packet carefully, then contact RinCon's Exhibitor Champion (exhibitor@rincongames.com) for more details. Thank you for supporting RinCon!

HOTEL

SAGA has reserved a group rate at Casino Del Sol. RinCon is being held in the convention space adjoining the casino/hotel. Please reserve your hotel room(s) by using our registration code to access the room block. For more information, please call Casino Del Sol at 855-765-7829, ask for a room in the RinCon block.

LOCATION AND SECURITY

The RinCon Exhibitor Hall will be conveniently located with the gaming space in the Grand Ballroom of the Casino Del Sol conference center. The Exhibitor section of the ballroom will be sealed off and locked after hours for security.

EXHIBITION BOOTHS

There are 3 types of exhibitor booths - Individual, Standard, and Deluxe.

- Each booth includes an ad in the overhead slide presentation during RinCon, as well as the business' logo to be featured in RinCon promotional materials.
- Ads/logo must be received by **September 2, 2026**, or they will not appear.
- Exhibitors are required to make a donation of goods to our raffles/prize pool along with a business card for promotional display by **September 25, 2026**.

Individual Exhibitor booth:

- ~6'x8' space in secure Exhibitor area (exact dimensions/layout TBD)
- Two (2) rectangle 6' tables (one 18" wide, one 30" wide) & 2 chairs
- 2 Exhibitor badges (additional Exhibitor badges available for \$35 each)

Standard Exhibitor booth:

- ~10'x10' space in secure Exhibitor area (exact dimensions/layout TBD)
- Two (2) 6' rectangular tables & 2 chairs (additional chairs available at no charge)
- 3 Exhibitor badges (additional Exhibitor badges available for \$35 each)

Deluxe Exhibitor booth:

- ~10'x15' space in secure Exhibitor area (exact dimensions/layout TBD)
- Three 6' rectangular tables & 2 chairs (additional chairs available at no charge)
- One (1) Demo table in the main gaming area for programming, if desired
- 4 Exhibitor badges total (additional Exhibitor badges available for \$35 each)

EXHIBITION COST

Costs must be paid by check or money order (payable to SAGA) or by Paypal (payable to payments@rincongames.com) by **September 4, 2026**. Booths are not secured until payment and application/terms of use agreement are received.

- Individual booth exhibitor registration: **\$175.**
- Standard booth exhibitor registration: **\$375.**
- Deluxe booth exhibitor registration: **\$500.**

Costs include a non-refundable \$75 for a temporary business license with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe. Should multiple businesses share a booth, each must apply for a separate license, at an additional \$75 charge. Should the Pascua Yaqui Tribe increase the business license fee, the exhibitor will be responsible for the additional cost.

RinCoin Incentive Policy

In an effort to drive traffic to the Exhibitor booths, RinCon will provide an incentive program known as RinCoins. See Exhibitor Application for details.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance projections for RinCon are approximately **650** unique attendees. SAGA will run tabletop gaming events and direct attendee foot traffic to the RinCon Exhibitor Hall.

HOURS

RinCon will be open to attendees 24 hours a day, however the secured Exhibitor area will be open the following hours:

Sat **10/3**: 9am - 7pm

Sun **10/4**: 9am - 4pm (tear down: 4pm)

RinCoin Incentive Policy

The purpose of this program is to give attendees an incentive to visit exhibitor booths and make purchases. Winners of certain events and some GMs will earn RinCoins as prizes. These RinCoins will be redeemable for RinCon raffle tickets and at participating exhibitor booths. Attendees redeem RinCoins at participating Exhibitors at a rate of **\$1** each toward the purchase of merchandise. The number of RinCoins accepted is entirely up to the Exhibitor.

At the close of RinCon, Exhibitors reserving a booth for the following RinCon event will receive a reduced rate based on the number of RinCoins they turn in. Each RinCoin will count as **\$2** toward the following year's booth fees or advertising. A maximum of **25** RinCoins will be accepted this way. Payment for booths reserved in this manner will be due by published deadline of the following year or the rate will revert to the standard booth rate.

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Terms of Use Agreement

This is an agreement between the Southern Arizona Gamers Association (SAGA) and the undersigned exhibitor (Exhibitor).

Whereas, SAGA desires to develop a convention for the hobby games community (RinCon); and whereas, Exhibitor desires to retain the services of SAGA to develop an exhibitor hall during RinCon to display product for educational, entertainment, and commercial purposes.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the conditions set forth herein, both parties agree as follows:

SAGA OBLIGATIONS

1. **VENUE.** SAGA shall organize RinCon as a three-day gaming convention **October 2 - 4, 2026**, at the **Casino Del Sol Conference Center**, barring any unforeseen circumstances which prevent the venue from being available.
2. **SPONSOR HALL.** SAGA shall provide an exhibitor hall at RinCon wherein exhibitors may conduct business. Exhibitor shall be granted an exhibitor booth as described above in the exhibitor application. Exhibitor booth assignment and details are the sole responsibility of RinCon staff.
3. **SALE OF GOODS.** SAGA shall provide exhibitor hours that are reasonable in length for Exhibitor to conduct business. To facilitate sales within the exhibitor hall, SAGA shall create exclusivity of sales for certain exhibitor product. RinCon staff reserves the right to grant exclusivity of sales to non-publishing exhibitors only when express written permission of the publisher is provided.
4. **MARKETING.** SAGA shall reasonably promote RinCon and exhibitors prior to the start of the convention. This marketing effort shall include but not be limited to: distribution of marketing material at SAGA functions prior to RinCon, cross-promoting with other local businesses, providing press releases to appropriate media outlets, and creating a functional website to attract attendance.
5. **ACCESS.** SAGA shall provide each exhibitor with exhibitor badges according to the exhibitor application above. Exhibitor badges grant Exhibitor access to all scheduled programming at RinCon after exhibitor hall hours, and to the Hospitality Suite. Only exhibitors wearing Exhibitor badges shall be granted access to the exhibitor hall during setup and tear down.
6. **INCENTIVES.** SAGA shall create incentives to visit the exhibitor hall. These incentives include but are not limited to: traffic-generating convention games and dealer dollars (RinCoins). These incentives are intended to increase traffic to the exhibitor area and help generate overall sales.

EXHIBITOR OBLIGATIONS

7. **PAYMENT.** Exhibitor shall provide payment to SAGA in full according to the fee schedule described above in the exhibitor application. Exhibitors have until **September 4, 2026,*** to make all payments; after this date, SAGA reserves the right to deny any exhibitor application. Space in the exhibitor hall is limited and is provided on a first come, first served basis.

* Note that discounted rates due to the RinCoin policy require that payments be made by **August 28, 2026**, or the rate will revert to the standard booth rate.
8. **CANCELLATION.** Exhibitor has the right to cancel this agreement and receive a full refund (minus the \$75 non-refundable application fee for a Pascua Yaqui temporary business license), only if written notification of such cancellation is received by RinCon staff on or before **September 4, 2026**. Exhibitors wishing to cancel their exhibitor booth after that date will forfeit all monies previously paid to SAGA. Exhibitor space costs will not be refunded. No exceptions to this cancellation condition shall be granted.
9. **RESPONSIBILITY.** Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for the operation and condition of their booth during RinCon. Exhibitor will conduct themselves in a professional manner consistent with ethical standards for business, and follow the RinCon Code of Conduct (see next page). SAGA shall take reasonable security precautions to limit access to the exhibitor hall while it is closed. However, Exhibitor agrees that SAGA, RinCon, and its director and staff, shall not be responsible for any items lost, damaged, destroyed, or stolen during RinCon. Further, Exhibitor is solely responsible for paying all applicable federal, state, and city taxes on sales and promotional activities at RinCon. Exhibitor also agrees that the rights granted in this agreement may not be sold, sublet, or otherwise transferred to any third party. This responsibility condition is included to preserve a high quality and professional environment for all the exhibitors, attendees, RinCon staff, and SAGA.
10. **SPONSOR HOURS.** Exhibitor is granted the right to conduct business in the secure exhibitor hall during the hours described in the Exhibitor Information Packet. This right may not be conveyed or transferred to Exhibitor outside of exhibitor hall hours or to any RinCon attendee for any reason. Further, exhibitor setup and teardown shall only occur during the times described in the Exhibitor Information Packet. RinCon staff reserves the right to limit exhibitor access during setup and teardown to control traffic and maintain the safety of attendees and the security of the facility.
11. **INCENTIVES.** Exhibitors choosing to participate in the RinCoin incentive program detailed in the Exhibitor Application agree to the terms as they are described above.
12. **LEGAL COMPLIANCE.** Exhibitor shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations for the United States of America, the State of Arizona, the Pascua Yaqui nation, Casino Del Sol, and SAGA. This requires Exhibitor to advertise, broadcast, present, and sell merchandise or intellectual property consistent with all US copyright and trademark agreements. Exhibitors in violation of this legal compliance condition will be asked to stop all illegal activity immediately. SAGA reserves the right to ask those exhibitors who are in violation of this condition to vacate RinCon at the forfeiture of all monies previously paid to SAGA. Casino Del Sol does not allow any outside food/beverage in the Conference Center; any food/beverage purchased at Casino Del Sol is allowed.
13. **SPONSOR EVENTS:** All scheduled events hosted by a Exhibitor **must** be submitted for publication in the RinCon schedule through the RinCon website, in the same manner as other hosted or scheduled events. This includes events or tournaments held in regular gaming spaces as well as on Exhibitors' Demo Tables (see below). Submissions must be received by **September 4, 2026**.
14. **USE OF DEMO TABLES:** Demo tables are intended for a) demonstrations of games, concepts, or merchandise being sold or represented by the Exhibitor, or b) events submitted to the RinCon schedule through the RinCon website, by the deadline of **September 4, 2026**. Exhibitors will not host or exhibitor scheduled events at their demo tables other than those submitted in this manner. All Exhibitors with demo tables shall submit at least one (1) event to the RinCon schedule per day of the convention, to be hosted at their demo table. Submissions must be received by **September 4, 2026**.
15. **DONATIONS:** All Exhibitors shall provide a donation of goods to the raffles/prize pool at RinCon along with a business card for promotional display by **September 25, 2026**.

This exhibitor application and terms of use agreement represent the full agreement between SAGA and Exhibitor and shall supersede any previous agreement, written or verbal, between the parties. Modifications to this agreement must be approved by both parties and completed in writing by **September 4, 2026**, or later at the sole discretion of SAGA staff.

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SAGA takes very seriously the responsibility of all participants to help create and maintain a welcoming and respectful environment at their event. The Exhibitor signatory below is responsible for ensuring that they and all their employees, team members, and representatives (including those running games at their demo tables or elsewhere at the convention) follow the RinCon Code of Conduct at all times. This extends to set-up and tear-down activities, and includes interactions with attendees, other casino guests, convention site staff, fellow sponsors/exhibitors, and RinCon volunteers and board. SAGA reserves the right to have any Exhibitor found to be in violation of this Code of Conduct vacate the premises immediately, at the forfeiture of all monies previously paid to SAGA.

SAGA / RINCON CODE OF CONDUCT

SAGA/RinCon is dedicated to providing a welcoming, inclusive experience for everyone, both in online/social media environments and at in-person events. In order for us as a community to do so, we all agree to uphold the following standards regarding safety and how we treat all participants (including host site staff, vendors, volunteers, etc.):

- We will support each other in creating a friendly, kind, and engaging social environment. We're all here to have fun!
- We will act respectfully throughout the event, including being sure that language, tone of voice, and non-verbal actions (gestures, body language, etc.) do not create an uncomfortable experience for others. We will deescalate situations when possible. We will refrain from using slurs and other language that reinforces social structures of domination related to gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, religion, etc.
- We will prioritize having fun in a game over winning or losing, and will use our presence to support each other and build community.
- We will respect others' limits and if someone feels uncomfortable, we will not question their choice to step away or use table safety tools like the [X card](#). We will also respect others' requests for clarification or explanation of game rules without judgment; we are here to grow the gaming community.
- We will refrain from unwanted sexual advances and inappropriate physical contact of other members. We will ensure we have enthusiastic consent before physically engaging with another person; past consent does not indicate current or future consent.
- We will not engage in deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, or unwanted photography or recording.
- We will not engage in sustained disruption of talks, panels, or other events. This includes interrupting, derailing or monopolizing conversations, and speaking over other individuals.
- We will support each other in maintaining a safe physical environment: no running, jumping, throwing, climbing, roughhousing, etc., and no engaging in behaviors that would cause others to feel afraid.
- Each of us is in charge of our own needs, physical (eating, sleeping, showering, medical needs, etc.) and mental/emotional. If we begin to feel stressed, angry, or physically bad in any way, we will do what it takes to get back on an even keel: step out for a quick break, have food/drink, take a walk or a bit of time in a quiet space, stretch, laugh, get some sunlight, or any other kind of self-care that will bring us back to having fun.
- We will treat others' belongings, including vendor and SAGA/RinCon property, with care and respect. This includes maintaining clean hands and play area when handling game materials.

We all have the right to advocate for our safety and identity. Participants asked to stop any behavior described above as inappropriate are expected to comply immediately. If you are being harassed, notice that someone else is being harassed, or have any other concerns, please contact a member of SAGA/RinCon staff immediately. If a participant engages in inappropriate behavior, the convention organizers may take any action they deem appropriate, including warning the offender or expulsion from the convention with no refund. If necessary at an in-person event, SAGA/RinCon staff will be happy to help participants contact venue security or local law enforcement, provide escorts, or otherwise assist those experiencing harassment to feel safe for the duration of the convention.
